



Les Wexner, Israel and Victoria's Dark Secrets

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Dimitri Lascaris: Good day, this is Dimitri Lascaris coming to you for Reason2Resist from Montreal, Canada on February 21st, 2026. Based on currently available information, no billionaire was closer to the disgraced paedophile Jeffrey Epstein than Leslie Wexner. Two days ago, Wexner was questioned under oath for almost five hours by multiple members of Congress. For some reason, he gave his testimony in his own palatial home. The video of the deposition has now been published. And I've had the misfortune of watching it in full. It's a doozy, and in this report, I'll explain why. Although Wexner claimed to have no recollection of events that any sane person would have recalled, and by all indications, he is at least sane, his testimony nonetheless revealed his deep connections to Israel's political elite. Wexner also revealed that Jeffrey Epstein represented the whole Rothschild family and was friends and business associates with Jeff Bezos, the Google guys, and Abigail Johnson, the CEO of the investment behemoth Fidelity Investments. In his deposition, Wexner's most stunning revelation was that despite the fact that the FBI has considered him to be a co-conspirator of Epstein, neither the FBI nor the Department of Justice has ever questioned Wexner in connection with the Epstein scandal. That's right folks, they've never even questioned him. That tells us all we need to know about how desperate the political elite is in the United States to bury the truth about Epstein's crimes and the crimes of his powerful associates.

In this episode, I'm going to share with you what I regard as the most astonishing excerpts from Wexner's testimony. And I'll also show you documents I found in the recently released Epstein files, which show that Epstein repeatedly lured unsuspecting minors into his sexual depravity den by holding himself out as a talent scout for Victoria's Secret, the largest lingerie retailer in the United States. Victoria's Secret, of course, was a major asset of L Brands, the multi-billion dollar company of which Wexner was the founder, CEO and chairman. Wexner was also a major shareholder of L brands. It is in fact this company that made Wexner filthy rich. Now, before we look at Wexner's deposition and the damning documents I've identified, I'd like to remind you, if you find this to be informative, please like and share this video. before the end of March. Now, to appreciate the significance of Wexner's testimony, it's important to understand, of course, the context.

Wexner met Epstein in the mid-1980s. Wexner says that although he initially found Epstein to be unremarkable, he hired him as a financial advisor within a year or less of meeting him. And he literally, he says, met him on the street in South Florida. He did hire him as a financial advisor eventually on the recommendation of some Wall Street honchos who knew Epstein and evidently vouched for him. Over the next 20 years, Wexner and Epstein would develop an extensive, elaborate and unfathomable financial relationship. Epstein held a power of attorney for Wexner's financial dealings from approximately 1986 to 2007. The L Brands corporate jet ended up being owned by Epstein. Wexner's mansion on the Upper East Side of Manhattan, about which I've done an extensive report, was also transferred to Epstein, a nearly 11,000 square foot home in New Albany, Ohio that was previously owned by Wexner was also transferred to Epstein. And that's by no means an exhaustive list of all the financial dealings between these two men. For Epstein's 50th birthday, Wexner gave Epstein a lewd birthday card. And I put it up here on the screen for you to peruse if you haven't already seen it. You'll see that it's dated January 20th, 2003 and says: "Dear Jeffrey, I wanted to get you what you want. So here it is". And in case you have any doubt about what that image is, it's two breasts which were hand-drawn by the dirty billionaire himself and at the end he writes, "happy birthday, your friend Leslie". After denying repeatedly in his deposition that Epstein was ever a friend of his, Wexner admitted that he had written this birthday note to Epstein and there's how he explained it.

Member of Congress (MC): Did Miss Maxwell approach you to write this letter for Mr. Epstein's birthday?

LW: I think the request was to write a card or a note or something for a birthday book.

MC: And did that come from Ms. Maxwell?

LW: I don't remember.

MC: Mr. Wexner, would you please read the main body of the birthday note for the record, please?

LW: I wanted to get you what you want. So here it is. Happy birthday, your friend Leslie.

MC: What was your understanding of what Mr. Epstein would want?

LW: He was a bachelor, so I drew a pair of boobs. As a kind of a joke, and offhandedly, I'd say.

MC: I understand. You've said a few times throughout this deposition today that you did not consider Mr. Epstein a friend of yours. However, you signed this letter, and I quote, "your friend, Leslie". Why would you sign "your friend, Leslie", to someone you did consider to be a friend yours?

LW: I don't know.

DL: Now, this lewd birthday note is by no means the worst evidence that has surfaced against Wexner. In 2016, Epstein victim Virginia Giuffre testified under oath in a defamation lawsuit that she had been trafficked to Wexner. You see up here on the screen she was asked: Was Les Wexner one of the powerful business executives that you were trafficked to?, and she said, yes. In his deposition Wexner made the incredible claim that up until he was asked about Virginia Giuffre in his deposition, he had never heard of her. And for clarification, the questioner pointed out that she had a maiden name, Roberts, and he was also asked if he had ever heard of Virginia Roberts and again, he made the incredibly claim that he had never heard of that name either, even though it was publicly discussed and widely discussed for many months prior to his deposition that Virginia Giuffre had testified under oath in a defamation lawsuit that she had been trafficked to Les Wexner. Now another woman, Maria Farmer, claimed in a sworn affidavit that Epstein raped her at Wexner's Ohio home. I believe that's the home at which this very deposition took place. This was reported by the New York Times. Farmer claimed that Wexner's security held her on premises for 12 hours and wouldn't allow her to leave. The DOJ originally redacted Wexner's name from key documents which discussed Epstein's co-conspirators. On February 10th of this year, just eleven days ago, Democratic Congressman Ro Khanna, and we should all applaud him for this, revealed to the world that despite the DOJ's efforts at concealment, he himself had confirmed that the FBI considered Wexner to be a co-conspirator of Epstein. And here's what the congressman had to say.

Ro Khanna: Mr. Speaker, yesterday, Congressman Massie and I went to the Department of Justice to read the unredacted Epstein files. We spent about two hours there and we learned that 70-80% of the files are still redacted. In fact, there were six wealthy, powerful men that the DOJ hid for no apparent reason. When Congressman Massie and I pointed this out to the Department of Justice, they acknowledged their mistake, and now they have revealed the identity of these six powerful men. These men are Salvatore Navora, Zorab Mikoladze, Leopoldo Leonor, Nicola Caputo, Sultan Ahmed bin Sulayem, CEO of Dubai Ports World, and billionaire businessman, Leslie Wexner, who was labelled as a co-conspirator by the FBI. Now my question is, why did it take Thomas Massie and me going to the Justice Department to get these six men's identities to become public?

DL: Good question indeed. By the way, you heard a female voice interject as the congressman was speaking. I don't know who that was. It sounds like somebody, maybe somebody from the Republican party, but I don't know, was trying to interrupt him but ultimately was unsuccessful. And one other footnote the person he refers to as Sultan, this creep who was the president or CEO of a massive Emirati corporation called DP World, which controls major ports around the world, has since departed his position as CEO of DP World although the announcement of his departure did not explicitly link it to the rather offensive and extremely troubling communications that he had with Epstein, including one in which Epstein appeared to express his appreciation for a torture video that Sultan may have provided to him. Now, Wexner claims that in or around 2008, he discovered that Epstein had

been stealing from him. The amount of the theft was estimated by the advisors to Wexner to be at least \$200 million. In his deposition this week, Wexner said that the amount Epstein stole could be even higher. He said over and over again that he might never know how much Epstein stole from him. In 2020, Wexner stepped down as CEO of L Brands as questions mounted about his relationship to the notorious paedophile. Despite Epstein's theft and his departure from the top job at L Brands, Wexner remains the state of Ohio's wealthiest man with an estimated net worth of \$9 billion. Wexner was not only a lingerie tycoon, he was also a fanatical and influential Zionist. His rather well endowed foundation, the Wexner Foundation, was explicitly established for the purpose of promoting what he perceives or it perceives to be Israel's interests in the United States and abroad. In addition to that, in 1991 with billionaire Charles Bronfman, Wexner formed the Mega Group, also known as the study group. And you'll see here, this was posted on X by somebody who was inquiring into this organisation. The Mega Group "is an informal network of influential Jewish American billionaires founded in 1991 by Wexner and Bronfman. It focuses on philanthropy, Jewish education programs like Birthright Israel and pro-Israel advocacy. Epstein reportedly used it to expand his business and political connections per various reports." Birthright Israel is not simply a Jewish education program. In fact, some Jews many of whom I know personally, would say that it's actually a miseducation program, its purpose is to brainwash young Jewish men and women that this land that they call Israel is the land of the Jewish people exclusively; their land by divine right. And over the years many courageous activists from the Jewish community have called out Birthright, oftentimes participating in its excursions across Palestine for the purpose of countering the propaganda that it is notorious for having implanted the minds of so many young Jewish persons.

Now, although it built itself as a promoter of Jewish philanthropy, clearly this group sought to influence US foreign policy in West Asia in 2003, it employed high-powered Republican consultant, Frank Luntz, to help the group mobilise support for Israel. In a 2024 Washington Times report, it was asserted that the group had contacts with the Israeli intelligence agency Mossad and served as a, quote, "vehicle for influence operations in the United States". Some of the more notable members of this group in addition to Bronfman and Wexner, and this is from Wikipedia, are Bronfmans, I believe that's his brother, or maybe a son, Edgar Bronfmann, Max Fisher, another wealthy Zionist plutocrat, Laurence Tisch, the owner of the New York Giants, or co-owner, I should say, Steven Spielberg, the Hollywood bigwig, Ronald Lauder, another very wealthy Jewish Zionist businessman from the United States. And again, this is only a partial list and the actual full list has not been published to my knowledge. Charles Bronfman's son Stephen Bronfman is the chief fundraiser for Canada's governing Liberal Party. And you can see here that back in 2017, Stephen Bronfman became mired in another scandal, one relating to offshore tax havens when documents referring to him were released publicly as part of the Pandora Papers. Although the Canadian press briefly reported upon that, that story evaporated from the Canadian corporate media mighty quickly thereafter. And as far as I know, he remains the chief revenue officer of the Liberal Party, and for those who don't know Canadian politics, the Liberal Party has held power in Canada federally. And in many provinces, for well over half the time since the end of the Second World War, it is probably the most successful political machine in Canadian political

history. And the current run of power for the Liberal Party extends all the way back to 2016. They've been in power without interruption since then. So being the primary money man for this particular political party buys you a lot of influence in Canada, I can assure you of that. Now, during his deposition, Wexner revealed just how cosy he is with the Israeli political elite. Here's Wexner, for example, talking about his relationship with Shimon Peres.

MC: It reads: In September 1997, Wexner celebrated his 60th birthday with a dinner at his Ohio estate. Meister says he used the occasion to once again tell Wexner how untrustworthy Epstein was. My wife and I told him and Abigail hundreds of times to stay away from Epstein. Mr Wexner, do you recall this occurring?

Lawyer: Objection double hearsay.

MC: Are you directing your witness to not answer?

Lawyer: No, no, no. I will direct the witness not to answer if that's my intent. I'm just raising an objection to the record.

LW: For reasons to understand this, I never had a birthday party for myself. In fact, I've never had birthday parties. My mom and dad just didn't do that. And Abigail's been great because every milestone birthday has been a surprise party. And I think, I don't remember for sure, but at the 60th birthday party, Senator Lieberman was there and Marshall Rose was there, Shimon Perez was there, John Glenn was there, Max Fisher was there. And I'm not sure he was there.

MC: Let me ask you a different question.

LW: He never said this. He wasn't there and he never said it.

DL: There's a lot to unpack there, but let me just focus for a moment on Shimon Peres. He said Peres came to his 60th birthday party in 1997. Later on in his deposition, he said that Peres came to a couple of his birthday parties, exactly how many we don't know. Nobody seemed particularly interested in this deposition in exploring the details and extent of his relationship with Shimon Peres. They did try to dig into his relationship with Ehud Barak because Ehud Barak's name appears all over the Epstein files, but Shimon Peres pretty much got a free pass. And it's important to understand that at the time of Wexner's 60th birthday party in 1997, Shimon Peres was arguably the most powerful politician in Israel. Prior to 1997, he had served as Prime Minister of Israel on no less than three occasions, including from 1995 to 1996. So when he went to the 1997 birthday party of Wexner, he had just completed his third term as Prime Minister. But it doesn't stop there. Peres was also the Defence Minister, the Finance Minister and the Foreign Minister of Israel on repeated occasions and a few years after the 1997 birthday party referenced in this testimony, Peres became the President of Israel, that was in 2007, and held that post for seven years. Now, you'll also have heard the names of Max Fisher and Joe Lieberman. They were at that party. Max Fisher, you may recall, was on that list of members of the Mega Group. As for Senator Joe Lieberman, those, the younger of you may not have heard of him before, but Lieberman

was initially a Democratic Senator. He was, without a doubt, one of the loudest and most obnoxious supporters of Israel in the United States Senate. And at some stage, he left the Democratic party because he felt that the slavishly pro-Israel Democratic party was not pro-Israel enough. Uh, so you can see in what kind of circles This man Leslie Wexner moved. Here's another clip from Wexner's deposition in which he discusses his friendship with another former Israeli Prime Minister, Ehud Barak.

MC: Do you ever have a relationship with the former Prime Minister?

Lawyer: Can you define relationship?

MC: I'm sorry, any relationship. Do you know Prime Minister Barak, if so, could you elaborate on how familiar you were with him?

LW: I was only with him a couple or three times in my life. I happened to be in Israel when he was elected but before he was sworn in as Prime Minister, we had a brief meeting in his political office, it wasn't the government office. I may have met him in Israel when he's Prime Minister but I don't recall. I know that I had dinner with him and I think his wife and daughter and Abigail in New York after he was out of office, I think. I don't think he was Prime Minister.

MC: Did you ever communicate with the Prime Minister outside of personal meetings, phone calls, emails?

LW: He came here once I think for Jewish community stuff and we went to a football game. That's all I remember.

MC: Did you ever communicate by email or phone call or other correspondence?

LW: I don't think I ever had his address or phone number or email address or text number or whatever.

MC: Are you aware of the Wexner Foundation or any other trusts or foundations or organisations affiliated with you ever donating money to the former Prime Minister?

LW: No.

MC: Would it surprise you if I told you that an FBI report stated – a report that the Wexner Foundation transferred at least \$2.3 million in US dollars to former Prime Minister Ehud Barak?

LW: I am shocked.

DL: Yeah, he's shocked. He's shocked that the FBI found that his foundation transferred at least 2.3 million dollars to Ehud Barak. This is a man who was running for decades a multi-billion dollar apparel giant, you know, largest lingerie retailer in the United States, made gobs of money but apparently was completely and utterly clueless as to how his

foundation was doling out money to former Prime Ministers of Israel. Shock was indeed the dominant theme of Wexner's deposition on countless occasions. He claimed to have no recollection of key facts or to have been totally ignorant of facts he should have known. When presented with these facts, Wexner claimed to be taken aback by them, just as you saw in this excerpt, and moreover, based on other parts of his deposition testimony, it seems odd that Wexner would be shocked to learn that his foundation was doling out millions of dollars to a former Israeli Prime Minister. Why do I say that? Well, here's Wexner talking about his relationship to Abba Eban, a former deputy Prime Minister of Israel.

LW: I regularly helped Abba Eban after he retired from government. And I probably would have started with writing a personal check and then I would speculate how it was paid. I don't remember writing the check. But Eban was a very good friend. And he had no money. He worked for the government of Israel. Social Security was his income, was nothing. He was like living in public housing. And my sense was that it wasn't fair. So I took care of him privately and his wife, Suzy, until they both died.

DL: Now why isn't it fair for a former politician to leave a very modest life materially after he leaves politics? Why is it fair for ordinary citizens, workers, working poor citizens of any country, whether it be Israel or another state, to live in public housing but somebody who served in high office where supposedly they are fulfilling their duty to the state and acting out of a profound sense of honour and public commitment, what's so unfair about them having to live in public housing on a state pension after they leave office? And by the way, if he had so little money, maybe that was due to his own financial shenanigans or incompetence. And I thought billionaires were of the view that people should suffer the consequences of their own financial mismanagement. In any case, I think what this demonstrates is a few things. First of all, this is really an exemplary of what happens not only in Israel, but across the West. We live in profoundly corrupt societies. I've talked about this quite a bit. In the West, we've legalised some of the more egregious forms of corruption. So what happens is, after politicians serve in public office and do the bidding of the billionaire class, which they almost invariably do in Western states and certainly in Israel. They get payoffs, but the payoffs are not in the form generally of cash provided to them in some envelope, they come in legalised forms. So, for example, they will be appointed to be a senior executive at some foundation where they run around the world schmoozing and living it up and making a fabulous salary for doing absolutely nothing but flapping their gums and uttering inanities. Then they oftentimes will be appointed to be of counsel on some big corporate law firm where they're paid hundreds of thousands of dollars a year, even seven figures, just to schmooze with clients. Other times, they're given lucrative lobbying posts where they parlay the connections they built up to the political elite into favours and concessions to the corporatocracy. And there are yet other ways. Sometimes they're appointed, you know, for example, like Annalena Baerbock, the warmongering pro-genocide psychopath who is now running the General Assembly of the United Nations, they're awarded some really plumb position in an international organisation, where they continue to lead the high life. So there's a myriad of ways in which the billionaire class manages to pay off the political servants after they leave office. And I would suggest to you that that's pretty much what's going on here, what went on

with Abba Eban. I doubt very much that Wexner was acting out of a sense of pity for the man. It was, I would hazard a guess, really just to pay off for the general servitude of this politician to the economic elite of Israel.

In any case, one other point I want to make about this, let's go back for a moment to the acknowledgement that, not in this particular excerpt but the one I showed you previously, that Ehud Barak socialised a good deal with Leslie Wexner. In the deposition, Wexner was adamant. He was absolutist and said it repeatedly that he cut off all communications with Epstein in 2008 when Epstein was convicted in a sweetheart deal for sexual crimes in the state of Florida. And at that time, according to Wexner, he found out he discovered this massive fraud or theft amounting to 200 million dollars or more from Wexner's assets. So he says at that point he's absolutely adamant about it. There was no further communication of any kind between him and Epstein. Now during the deposition one of the congressmen who was questioning Wexner presented to him credible reports that Epstein had made efforts to get in touch with Wexner in 2010 and 2011, but again, he stuck by his gun, said he had had no contact or communication of any kind with Epstein. And this brings me to Ehud Barak. It's well known that Epstein had a very close relationship to Ehud Barak. Ehud Barak is known to have stayed at Epstein's place on several occasions, sometimes with his wife, I'm talking about his opulent Manhattan mansion, and stayed for weeks at a time. He visited Epstein Island. His right-hand man who was serving at the time in Israeli intelligence, his name was Yoni Koren, also stayed at Epstein's residence repeatedly and for significant periods of time. And there's also an audio recording, which came out recently of Epstein back in 2016, I believe it was, shortly after Barak ceased to be the Prime Minister of Israel, counselling Barak to seek a posting on the board of directors of Palantir, which is run by that freak Alex Karp and which has a deep relationship to the Israeli military and is profoundly complicit in the mass murder of Palestinians in the ongoing genocide in Gaza. So at the same time as Wexner was socialising with Ehud Barak, presumably much of it in the United States, when he says they went to see a football game and they had dinner and so forth, Epstein was doing likewise, he was socialising with Ehud Barak. Now this is a small circle of very powerful actors in Zionist circles in the United States. It's not as though they're making friends on the street, it's a very small circle that they socialise with. It is kind of hard for me to believe that although Epstein and Wexner were both socialising in the United States with the former Prime Minister of Israel Ehud Barak at the same time that they never had any contact during this period. But I leave it to you to decide whether you find that to be a credible allegation or claim.

Now as I mentioned earlier I've spent a considerable amount of time looking at the references in the Epstein files to Victoria's Secret and if you search that phrase in the DOJ's Epstein library you'll generate about 360 hits. What I have found in my review of those documents is that again and again, over a period of 20 years or more, Epstein lured minors and very young women into his den of depravity by holding himself out as a model recruiter for Victoria's Secret. And the earliest example, that I found of this in the Epstein files that have been released to date – and bear in mind that credible analysis suggests that we've only seen about 2% of the documentation, the records that the DOJ acquired from Epstein's properties and

from the Epstein estate to date, so there are 360 hits in the very small number of documents that have been released to this point. And the earliest example, as I mentioned, that I found in these documents of Epstein reportedly using or claiming that he was a recruiter of models for Victoria's Secret in order to lure minors into his dens of depravity, that goes back to 1997. Now here you can see the second page of a two-page record of a sexual battery complaint that was filed with the Santa Monica police in May of 1997, and I've highlighted the most pertinent excerpt of this. This complainant reported to police that she initially met Epstein in April of that year through a mutual friend, and that mutual friend apparently told her that since she is a model she should give Epstein a call to get some work with Victoria's Secret catalogue. So whoever advised the complainant of this apparently had been told quite possibly by Epstein himself or somebody who knew Epstein that he could get her into the Victoria's Secret catalogue.

And now here is what another Epstein victim told the United States District Court in 2019, shortly after Epstein was reported to have committed suicide in a jail cell in New York City. She reported to the court: "I was a model in another country when I came to the United States. I was told by a Booker that I needed to meet with a man named Jeffrey Epstein who was the owner of Victoria's Secret. The Booker told me that Mr. Epstein could help me get into Victoria's Secrets' world. It was my childhood dream to be a Victoria's Secret model. So I went one day in the afternoon, I met Mr. Epstein in his office, in his mansion in New York. A woman introduced herself and suggested to me that I should be extremely nice to Mr. Epstein because if he liked me, he would probably have photographers shooting photos of me right away. They told me to go upstairs and directed me to Jeffrey Epstein's office. He came out in a white robe, chatted very briefly. I had my portfolio photos, but he didn't even look at it. Suddenly he took his robe off and got close to me. I got up to leave, but the door was locked. I didn't know what was going on. It was my first official meeting to be cast in the United States. I was a young girl and confused. He got very close to me and I had a skirt on. He started to touch my genitals. I refused him. Then he went to the massage table and showed me the vibrator." There are many such stories like this in the Epstein files, extremely disturbing accounts of how he lured them into his lair by making false claims or having his associates make false claims or who knows, maybe they were true, that he was a recruiter of models for Victoria's Secret.

Now I'm going to come back to the whole question of whether that might have been true a little later on. Now here is yet another example of this ruse being employed by Epstein. This one, which you're seeing up on the screen here, is an excerpt from an FBI record of an interview of an Epstein victim and you'll see there that the report says – this is I imagine an investigator police officer recording what they heard from the victim – "X, the name is redacted, wanted to be a superstar. Epstein told X that he had all these connections with models and he knew the head of Victoria's Secret. Epstein made a lot of promises", and it goes on from there, the evidentiary record. Here you have an email to Jeffrey Epstein in 2011 from somebody named Katya Gusarova. It's unclear who that is. This could be a fake name, but there's some speculation that this was one of the many Russian models who were either abused by Epstein or who became themselves recruiters of victims for Epstein. This name

appears quite a bit in the Epstein files, Katya Guserova, and in this email she's complaining to Epstein as follows, I've highlighted the relevant passage: "You promised me to organise an appointment with a doctor. You promised to introduce me to photographers, to some people from Victoria's Secret, to some celebrity. Words stayed words. You didn't do any step to help me to get my target. I'm not stupid girl and of course I feel like our friendship is not mutual", and Epstein protests above. You'll see he says, "I am and have been a friend. I sent you to Moscow. I told you I'd try to help you though the chances were close to zero, but on one simple condition that you do not lie to me. I told you the very first day and again the next week that I would try to help with one simple condition, you do not lie. You told me sorry, it won't happen again. And then you lied again." Imagine that Jeffrey Epstein, indignant, the pathological liar because according to him, he was lied to.

Now, there is some evidence that at least some of the women who met Epstein and Ghislaine Maxwell did eventually become Victoria's Secret models. Now, what I'm showing you up here is a screenshot of a travel blog on the website of somebody who became a Victoria's Secret model. This passage here, screenshotted from her website, was provided to the FBI by a third party, a man who was just interested apparently in trying to help the FBI investigation, and she doesn't claim in this excerpt to have been abused by Epstein. In fact, she has very complimentary things to say about him and Ghislaine Maxwell. I've highlighted this again, the relevant portion: "We still live in a man's world. Anyway, back to the dream job that could have launched the beginning of a career for me. I was with Ford models. I was sent to a casting in New York, but organised through someone from my agency in Milano. I was to see the man who owned and was the financier of Victoria's Secret, La Senza, Pink of the Limited Brands. Best mate with the CEO and founder, Mr. Blank." Why would that be deleted? Presumably the redaction there is of the name of Wexner because he was the CEO and founder at that time of L brands and indirectly the person who was running Victoria's Secret. These redactions were only supposed to be done either for national security purposes or to protect ongoing investigations and there's no indication as I'm going to explain a little later on that the FBI or DOJ have any interest in investigating Wexner. And finally, most importantly, the redactions were primarily to be done to protect the identities of the victims. This is absolutely positively an unjustifiable redaction and it almost certainly was done by the DOJ to protect Wexner.

In any case, the author of this post goes on to say, "I was met by a very sweet and kind Ghislaine Maxwell that I later came to know was the daughter of the mysteriously deceased media titan who looked at my photo portfolio and confirmed the casting with the LTD people. I saw two people and the meeting went very well. Subsequently, I came back to blank where a season in blank was about to start and awaited me. I was chosen to be the next Victoria's Secret model. I was flown back to New York, no strings attached and put in my own apartment for a few days in Manhattan and flown on a private jet to Palm Beach where I was going to meet the photographer." And of course Epstein had a Palm Beach resort or residence which was used extensively for the purpose of abusing minors and very young women. So if this account is true, we know that at least one woman actually did become a Victoria's Secret model, possibly as a result of the efforts of Epstein and Ghislaine Maxwell, his co-criminal.

[00:40:00] And so it's entirely possible that when Epstein was telling all of these women and girls that he was a recruiter for Victoria's Secret that he was actually telling the truth. He may have had some informal relationship with them there may have been a mutual pact between them which wasn't necessarily recorded in writing, whereby he was allowed to use the name of Victoria's Secret in order to make himself more attractive to young aspiring models and Victoria's Secret tolerated this knew it and tolerated it at the highest levels because he occasionally did find young women whom Victoria's Secret wanted to employ as models. I'm not saying that that is in fact the case but it's a possibility. Now in his deposition Wexner is adamant that Epstein was never a recruiter for Victoria's Secret and that if he had known that any of the models were coming from Epstein, he would have put a stop to it. He said that wasn't proper industry practise, but for a whole bunch of reasons, some of which I've highlighted, I don't think we should be attaching too much importance to the testimony of Leslie Wexner.

Now moving on, again staying on the question of evidence that Epstein was using this claim to lure minors and young women, here is a particularly disturbing, quite appalling account given to the FBI in 2019 by an Epstein victim. And this is the record of the account taken down, presumably by an FBI investigator. The victim says that she was modelling in 2015 – for some reason, they've redacted her age, I don't know why they would do that – when she met Epstein. She attended parties at Epstein's residence in New York. During one of the parties, Epstein asked her to take a tour of blank. And then Epstein asked her apparently after she accepted the invitation for a tour to take off her panties. When she didn't comply, he said, it's fine, I'll pay you \$500. She complied because she thought he was a very important person. In 2016, Epstein slid his fingers up her dress and fingered her at one of the parties. Two twin brothers, Alon and Oren, who were involved in real estate lured, apparently this young lady and her friend whose name is redacted upstairs and locked the door. Somebody, presumably the friend who went upstairs with her, knocked the door back open and the two ran away. And then she stated to the police that Oren raped someone, presumably her friend or someone else that she knew and Oren's brother Tal raped a 14-year-old girl whose name is redacted who tried to slit her wrist after the incident.

Now this account continues. Before I tell you what the next portion says, I just wanna stop there in reference to these individuals that she's talking about. They are almost certainly Tal, Oren and Alon Alexander. They are Israeli-American real estate agents who focused on the New York and Miami ultra luxury property markets. They are currently right now on trial in New York City on multiple criminal charges, including sex trafficking and sexual assault. Following allegations, they drugged and raped women for more than a decade. And I guess the bizarre thing about all of this is that these three characters deny having had any connection with Epstein. Apparently Epstein is too heinous even for them. But as you just saw, it was alleged by a young woman who went to the FBI that there were rapes or attempted rapes carried out by these three brothers or two of them at Epstein's mansion. Now in her account she went on to say this. This is the second page from the FBI record of her interview. I've highlighted here: She also went to Epstein's St. Thomas island, which he referred to as St. Jeffrey. In fact, I think she's talking about St. James island. That's what it

was called. Epstein and other powerful men, including Bill Clinton and Donald Trump, would have big orgy parties with her, other young girls, I repeat girls, and older Victoria's Secret models. So I don't know whether the FBI has pursued this set of allegations in connection with Bill Clinton or Donald Trump but by all indications they have absolutely no interest. Now in 2020 a man named Steve Scully who said he knew Epstein and had visited Epstein island told the FBI that he had seen five Victoria's Secret models on Epstein island. And here you can see an intake form where Scully is giving his account and he says there in the middle of the page, on one occasion Scully arrived on the island and there were five girls on the dock. Scully was told they were all Victoria's Secret models. In 2007 moreover a young woman by the name of Eva Cordero filed a lawsuit against Epstein. This was in New York State Court. She initially named only Epstein, but then quickly added Victoria's Secret and Leslie Wexner himself as defendants. And here you can see the first page of a decision that was rendered in that litigation in the following year in October 2008. Before I tell you about this decision, Cordero alleged that Epstein had abused her as a child and that she had been lured into his trap by Epstein's claims that he was a recruiter for Victoria's Secret. She also alleged that Victoria's Secret and Les Wexner knowingly allowed Epstein to make these representations. So what happened in this decision rendered by the New York court in 2008? Sadly for this victim, the court dismissed her claim but not on the basis of the merits of the claim, rather the court ruled that the claim was filed too late under the applicable statute of limitations in New York State. So no court has ever adjudicated Cordero's allegations that Wexner and Victoria's Secret knowingly allowed Epstein to use representations that he was a model recruiter for Victoria's Secret to lure her and others into his traps. Eva Cordero, after receiving this decision, filed an appeal in which she sought to have the decision overturned so that her claim could be determined on the merits. But before the appeal was actually heard, she withdrew it because Epstein paid her \$28,000 to abandon the appeal. Now, almost one decade later, in a cruel twist of fate, Cordero was arrested. And the reason that she was arrested was because she was caught breaking into a Victoria's Secret store in New York City for the purpose of stealing underwear. And this is a report which made it all the way to the Times of Israel back in March, 2017. Cordero was charged at the time with grand larceny and burglary. Before her trial, the court ordered a psychological evaluation due to concerns that she was mentally unfit at the time of the alleged theft. Now during his deposition, Wexner was asked why he never pressed charges against Epstein despite his belief that Epstein stole hundreds of millions of dollars from him. And here's how Wexner responded.

MC: The question is why didn't you file any charges against Epstein if he conned you of the \$200 million that we know of? Why didn't you go after him?

LW: Well, at the time, I didn't know.

MC: But when you found out why didn't you go after him? Is it because he was a good friend?

LW: No.

LW: My dad is probably laughing. One of the things my dad told me is that you don't get into a pissing contest with an elephant. And running a public company for a long time I'm not good at public relations or financial public relations and so I would answer questions to analysts, I'd call people up and I'd tell them the truth. And what I learned in the course of my business career is, whether it was my chief of staff, the company lawyer, personal lawyers, what should I do?! And the advice is let us handle it. You don't want to get ahead of this. So I'm happy that today is happening because I want to help and I would do everything I can to nail that son of a bitch, and I'm...

Lawyer: Please let him finish.

LW: And I can't tell you how much I value my own ethics, my own moral compass, that it has a true North.

DL: So, while Wexner was still the CEO of the company that owned Victoria's Secret, he was the CEO at that time in 2017 when Eva Cordero was charged with grand larceny, Victoria's secret pressed charges against Cordero, an alleged victim of Epstein who allegedly used the name of Victoria's secret to lure Cordero at a time she was a minor into his clutches. They charged her, they pressed charges for grand larceny, but Wexner did not press charges against Epstein for stealing at least \$200 million from him?! This is what Wexner calls a moral compass with a true North. The other thing I find amazing about this, you know, I myself, I've been practising law for over 30 years, I'd been a litigator, and the primary activity that I had pursued as a litigator after I left Wall Street in the 90s where I was a securities and banking lawyer was to sue public companies in class actions for securities fraud, directors and officers of public companies and the companies themselves for misleading the market. What I found absolutely stunning about this passage that I just showed you is that Wexner said that he wasn't good at public relations – he called it financial public relations – because when he spoke to analysts, he told them the truth. Well, that's exactly what you're obliged to do under the law. If you make material misrepresentations to the investing public or investment analysts, which later have detrimental impacts on investors, you can go to jail. You can certainly get sued. So Wexner in his deranged moral universe, Mr. Moral Compass with a true North thinks that it was a failing on his part that he was supposedly honest with analysts when he was the CEO of this massive multi-billion dollar company. But at the end of the day, he actually provides no credible or even coherent explanation as to why he let Jeffrey Epstein off the hook while his company, the one that he indirectly controlled as the CEO, Victoria's Secret, pressed charges for grand larceny against this alleged minor victim of Jeffrey Epstein. So we're therefore left to speculate as to why Wexner would give Epstein a free pass for this monumental theft. And here are, I suggest to you, three possibilities. One, Epstein never actually stole that money, rather, Wexler gave him the money, and gave it to him for reasons he does not want to have to explain to anybody and therefore Wexner is now lying about the theft and because Epstein is dead – presumably he's dead although I wouldn't assume that that's true but officially he's dead – and so he's not around to defend himself from the allegation of theft. So that's the number one possibility the theft actually didn't happen, it's just a cover story so that Wexner doesn't have to explain why he voluntarily gave all of this

money to Epstein. Possibility number two, Epstein had compromising evidence about Wexner and blackmailed him. For example, maybe Epstein could prove that Virginia Giuffre was trafficked to the ageing greed meister. And finally, another possibility is that Wexner understood that Epstein was an asset of Israeli intelligence and out of deference to Wexner's beloved genocidal entity, Wexner let Epstein get away with this massive theft. I'll leave you to decide why this greedy-ass billionaire never tried to hold Epstein accountable for this alleged theft, while the company of which he was indirectly the CEO pressed charges for grand larceny against Eva Cordero.

Now returning to Epstein's practice of telling his victims that he was a model recruiter for Victoria's Secret, Wexner was asked about this no less than three times during his deposition. The first two times that he was asked, he simply said that he was told once, he repeated it, once that Epstein was making this claim to his victims, but that on that occasion when he was told, he couldn't recall any of the details. He couldn't recall who told him, he couldn't recall exactly what he was told, he couldn't remember how he reacted to the news that Epstein was doing this. So about that, as I say, he was asked twice and that's the answer he gave. I was told on one occasion and one occasion only that Epstein was doing this and I don't remember anything else. Now, at the very end of his deposition, you had to go through four and a half hours of this shit show in order to get to this part, which was certainly one of the most revealing parts of the entire deposition, he gets asked a third time about what he knew and when he knew it in relation to Epstein's use of the model recruiter for Victoria's Secrets line to lure victims into his sexual abuse traps. This time, on the third occasion near the end of the deposition, by which point the ageing billionaire was visibly tired, he was much more revealing. And I'm going to share with you what he had to say, and we'll go through this step by step. It's a bit of a long excerpt, but I think it bears watching in some detail. And as I do this, I'm gonna remind you that this was my bread and butter for 30 years, was deposing people like this. I've deposed people like this, executives of public companies in this type of a context on countless occasions. So I'm gonna offer you a perspective which is based on a significant body of relevant experience, I would say. [

MC: I'd like to touch on Victoria's Secret and Mr. Epstein presenting himself as a recruiter. Again, I know it's been discussed earlier. I'll try to cover new ground to the extent possible. I think you had testified that you were alerted to that issue once. It's been publicly reported that in 1993, President Cynthia Fedus-Fields, who was an executive at Victoria's Secret at the time, was alerted that Epstein was holding himself out as a Victoria's Secret scout and that you were alerted to the problem and quote said that "you would stop it".

DL: Just pausing there, remember I said earlier that the earliest evidence I found that Epstein was doing this was the Santa Monica complaint back in 1997. So apparently there's evidence that Epstein was doing even before then, four years earlier in 1993. Who knows how far back in time this practice may have been going on. He may have done it, Epstein, claiming falsely or honestly that he was a recruiter for Victoria's Secret in using this to entrap minors and young women, but in any case, we're now being told for the first time that no later than 1993, Wexner was put on notice about this. And this is what Wexner says.

MC: I'll try to cover new ground to the extent possible. I think you had testified that you were alerted to that issue once. It's been publicly reported that in 1993, President Cynthia Fedus-Fields, who was an executive at Victoria's Secret at the time, was alerted that Epstein was holding himself out as a Victoria's Secret scout and that you were alerted to the problem and, quote, said "that you would stop it". Does that sound like the time frame in which you recall being told about the issue?

LW: Maybe. It could have been. I was trying to think when she worked in the business and when she left, but yeah, probably right, I don't know for sure.

MC: What do you specifically recall about when you were alerted to the issue? In other words, who approached you and what did they describe specifically?

LW: Something like: Jeffrey's trying to pick up women and he says he's a Victoria's Secret talent scout. And I said: Terrible nonsense or I'll put a stop to it.

DL: Alright, this is very important. He is admitting that he knew this back in 1993, and he's now purporting to recall how he responded. So this is not a man who has a hazy recollection. Well, we're talking back, you know, 33 years from the time he's being deposed two days ago, and he is recounting how he responded. And most importantly, he acknowledges that he was told that Epstein was using this line to pick up women. Okay, he wasn't making it for purposes of ingratiating himself with business people and trying to get deals done. He was actually using it to try to have sex with women and he continues.

LW: Something like that. It could be possible I think in my memory, but I didn't believe it, but I know I called him up and said: Jeffrey, what is going on? He said: Do you think I'm stupid? I said: I hope not, because if not, you'll be dead. It was a very brief conversation. I remember him being definite about it; it didn't happen. It wasn't a long conversation, I was mad.

DL: I hope not or you'll be dead. I'm going to give the decrepit Zionist billionaire the benefit of the doubt and assume that he was speaking figuratively and not that he actually threatening Epstein with death. Although if he had threatened him with death and carried it out, he would have spared a lot of girls and young women a tremendous amount of suffering. He continues.

MC: So it was a blanket denial from Mr. Epstein.

LW: That's very accurate.

MC: And did you believe or were you convinced by his denial at the time?

LW: At the time, yes, I did believe it.

MC: So is it right that you were no longer upset following that conversation because you believed that he had not, in fact, held himself out as a scout?

LW: That's accurate, yes. That's how I felt.

MC: Do you recall whether you had the impression that your executives simply made the story up?

LW: I don't recall. Just knowing how I think about things I probably would have said this is just... Jeffrey is single, it's a thing to say, a rumour could get started, I gotta chase it down, because God forbid that anybody was in the business, let alone outside the business was dating people in the businesses or dating models or recruiting them or any of the stuff that we now know is true, I would have fired them on the spot.

MC: In May 1997, a young woman named Alicia Arden says that she was introduced to a man who identified himself as a talent scout for Victoria's Secret. That was Jeffrey Epstein. Mr. Epstein allegedly invited Ms. Arden to his hotel room in Santa Monica, California, to...

DL: So you're hearing now about the 1997 complaint, Santa Monica, which I mentioned earlier, this congressman for some reason is identifying the victim, the complainant, even though her name was blacked out from the police report that's in the Epstein files. I don't know why he's doing that. I do believe that this is a Republican congressman who's asking these questions.

MC: Addition for the catalogue. When she arrived, Mr. Epstein grabbed her, tried to undress her, and said he wanted to quote, "manhandle her". Ms. Arden fled in tears and filed a police report. It's one of the earliest allegations that are known against Mr. Epstein. Were you alerted to this sexual assault at the time?

Lawyer: Same objection to hearsay.

LW: Kind of the same answer. I don't know how I knew about it. I called Jeffrey, like, what the hell's going on, Jeffrey? And he was like, do you think I'm stupid?

DL: Okay, so you have there an acknowledgement now that he learned of this a second time, that years later he learned that Epstein was holding himself out to be a recruiter of models was using that line to entice young aspiring models and that in this case he not only understood that Epstein was using it to pick up adult women but there was a specific allegation that he used the line to entrap a minor and attempted to sexually assault the minor. So he's admitting now that he knew this is the second attempt. Suddenly he's remembering this, whereas on the prior two occasions he was asked about this in his deposition he said he was only ever told once about this practice by Epstein and wasn't able to recall any details about what he was told or how he responded to it.

LW: This was a bad girl, you know, I was on a date, she made all this stuff up. You don't think I'd behave this way, would you? And I'm like, I hope not, is probably what I said. Because I couldn't believe that anybody that I knew would behave like that.

MC: And what you're describing, is that the original single conversation you described earlier or is that a separate conversation with Mr. Epstein about the issue?

LW: I'm a little confused, but the – this question about the lady in the hotel in New York was one conversation, and the notion or the discussion about Jeffrey is interviewing models I think was a separate one, and they didn't happen simultaneously.

MC: I understand. It sounds like that might have been about four years apart from each other.

LW: You could tell me four years or four months, I don't remember.

MC: So it sounds like at that point, there would have been at least two conversations with Mr. Epstein about the broader Victoria's Secret issue. In 2004, a woman named Elisabetta Tai had a similar experience. She was invited to Mr. Epstein's New York home under the impression that he would be able to get her job as a Victoria's Secret model. Mr. Epstein allegedly undressed and handed her a vibrator. Miss Tai threw the vibrator at his head and ran out of the room.

DL: All right, so as you can see from his gaping mouth, he's gonna tell the questioner: Oh, I had no idea about that, oh, it's so shocking. But I just wanna point out here, this is 2004, okay? So we are not yet up to the lawsuit brought by Eva Cordero in 2007, I'm gonna come back to that.

MC: Were you made aware of this allegation at the time?

LW: I never heard this story before.

MC: In 2005, the New York Post ran an article describing a Romanian model who allegedly landed a gig at Wexner's Victoria's Secret brand thanks to Mr. Epstein. Did you have any knowledge about models who actually acquired jobs at Victoria's Secret directly or indirectly through Mr. Epstein?

LW: No. But I did not meet, interview, or pick models. That wasn't what I did and no one in the business did.

DL: So I just want to pause there. I think as a questioner, he made a mistake. He didn't ask him the right question or he didn't ask the right follow-up question. What he should have first asked him was: Were you aware of this report? And then let him explain what he did about it. Very hard to believe, very hard to belief that in 2018, the New York Post, which by the way, is one of the most fanatically pro-Israel newspapers in the United States, and I'm sure is widely read by fanatical Zionists like Wexner, but even if he'd never read the New York Post in his entire life, the New York post has a large audience and for them to report this and for it not to come to the attention of the management of Victoria's Secret, who almost certainly would have passed this information up the chain of command to Wexner, who was still the CEO of L Brands at that time, that just strains credulity. So I would have asked him: Did you ever read this report or did this report at any time come to your attention first, and then ask him whether he believed that Epstein was in fact recruiting women to be models for Victoria's Secret.

MC: But just to phrase it clearly, to your knowledge, did Victoria's Secret ever hire or contract with a model at the recommendation of Jeffrey Epstein?

LW: I can't imagine they did. I wouldn't know if they did, but the way that we handled our marketing, it couldn't have happened. I think I would have known because it just wasn't the practice.

MC: Could I ask one follow-up question? With respect to that second conversation and the young woman named Alicia Arden, I know they were a few years apart, but if you recall, was there any part of you that doubted whether Mr. Epstein had been truthful in his denial with you the first time?

LW: At the time, I don't think I connected them. You can't imagine how busy I was. I was engaged, I was married, I'm running 20 businesses. I never made the connection.

MC: And as far as you recall, those are the only two times that you were alerted to Mr. Epstein holding himself out as affiliated with Victoria's Secret.

LW: Those stories, yeah.

DL: What the hell did he mean when he said I never made the connection. He has a report in 1993 that Epstein is running around claiming to be a model recruiter for Victoria's Secret and is using the line to have sex with women and four years later, not an eternity later, he's told the same thing again this time the information is coming to him as a result of a complaint filed with the police in Santa Monica by somebody who said she was a minor and that he basically tried to force himself on her and he didn't make the connection. What does that even mean? At that point a sane person who has a "moral compass with a true North" would stop and say you know there's evidence accumulating to that you are lying to me Epstein and I need to take steps to protect the organisation and these young women you're approaching with this line. So there's absolutely no indication he did anything of the kind. Now, another complaint I have about the way this questioning unfolded, and I must say, this particular question you've just heard from probably did a better job than anybody else, at least insofar as this issue is concerned, the issue of Epstein holding himself out as a model recruiter for Victoria's Secret. He still made a mistake, and the mistake was nobody, and it wasn't just his mistake, nobody in that nearly five hours asked Wexner about the Cordero lawsuit in 2007. And why is this important? It's important first of all because there was an explicit allegation in that lawsuit that the complainant who was a minor at the time was abused by Epstein and that this was done knowingly, that Epstein was knowingly permitted by Wexner and by Victoria's Secret to make that claim for the purpose of enticing minors into his clutches. I find it impossible to believe, impossible to believe that that lawsuit was not brought to the attention of Les Wexner as soon as it was filed. This was a grave allegation which affected him personally, his standing personally, had the potential to expose him to a very considerable liability and lasting permanent damage to his reputation if it was proven to be true. He was named as a defendant personally for Christ's sakes. So he had to hire counsel and respond to the complaint, which I'm sure he did. He must have known about the

complaint. So it's the most obvious question in the world: When you were named as a defendant in this lawsuit, you'd already been told twice, you were told back in 1993, and then in 1997, a criminal complaint is filed against Epstein, now you're sued personally, and Victoria's Secret, this company that is of so much importance to you that you helped to build is being accused as well of being aware of all of this, what did you do? What steps did you take to protect these women, future victims of Jeffrey Epstein from this nefarious practice he had adopted of using Victoria's Secret to entice victims?! But the question never got asked. So I would say to you there is at least, there's at least three occasions, there has to be at least three occasions on which Les Wexner was told years before Epstein was finally arrested by the FBI in 2019 that Epstein was making this claim and was using the claim to entice minors and to sexually assault minors, and he did not a goddamn thing to stop it. Calling up Epstein confronting him with the accusation and then taking his word for it is not meaningful action. It is a meaningless action. Even if he trusted the man he had a larger responsibility to aspiring young models who might meet Epstein who might be approached by Epstein and he had a fiduciary responsibility to L Brands as a CEO to act in its best interest. And I think that the evidence, even if we just ignore Cordero altogether, there's plenty of evidence that at a bare minimum, at a bare minimum, the senior management of Victoria's Secret and L Brand were negligent. And I would go so far as to say that you could probably establish that they knew that Epstein was engaging in this practice and that it was enabling him to commit these crimes. It was facilitating his crimes and they did nothing about it, nothing. And that certainly would expose L Brands to potentially enormous liability to every single victim – and there are over 1200 victims according to the FBI, who knows how many were enticed with this line by Jeffrey Epstein into his clutches – they would potentially be on the hook for hundreds of millions, I'm talking here Wexner himself and L Brands for their negligent failure to stop Epstein. And although I don't report to be an expert in criminal law, particularly US criminal law, I strongly suspect that there could potentially be here criminal liability for the organisation and for Wexner as well if it were established that they knew that Epstein was doing this and did nothing to stop it and particularly if it were to be established that they not only knew it but that the reason they allowed it to go on is because Epstein, was in fact recruiting some very promising young models to work for Victoria's Secret, so that there was an exchange between them and Victoria's Secret management said: Yeah, we're gonna let this go on because we're getting something out of it. We're getting attractive young models who are being recruited by Jeffrey Epstein. None of this has been fully explored. I think it's absolutely disgusting and appalling that L Brands has not paid out huge sums of money to these victims and that Wexner himself, to my knowledge, neither Wexner nor L Brands, has paid a dime of compensation to women who were trafficked by or to Jeffrey Epstein when he held himself out as a model recruiter for Victoria's Secret.

Now I'm going to conclude by sharing with you what is undoubtedly in my view, well at least, the most shocking revelation of all from this tawdry five-hour deposition. At this stage, there is no reason to believe that the corrupt Department of Justice will do anything to hold this disgusting man accountable. Why do I say that? Because after all this time, according to Wexner himself, neither the Department of Justice nor the FBI has so much as questioned Wexner about his dealings with the depraved paedophile.

MC: Did the FBI or Department of Justice ever directly speak to you about Epstein or Maxwell? Has the FBI or DOJ ever directly contacted you or spoken to you about the FBI?

LW: Not to me.

MC: Never?

LW: Never.

DL: Can we now say that the FBI and DOJ are themselves criminal organisations? Case closed.
